From July 25 to 28, 2018, Binh Thuan Forestry Company, under the guidance of the Technical Consultancy Unit, is the Sustainable Forest Management and Forest Certification Institute (SFMI) implemented the internal assessment for all forest management activities in the area of forest and forest land are managed by the company.

The results of the internal assessment find there are 10 minor CARs and 2 observations. Implementing the content of the memorandum of understanding between the two sides at the meeting on October, 28 2018, the Company's leader board and FSC's Board and enterprises organized activities to overcome non-compliances.
